# Sponsored Parachute Jump

## Who can jump?

You must be over 16 and under 50. Your parents must sign a consent form if you are aged between 16-18. You need a doctor's certificate if you're over 50.

## How much do I have to raise?

You need to collect at least €650 in sponsorship before either training or jumping can take place.

## How do I apply?

Contact us using the details below. Give us your name and address and we'll post you the relevant information.

## What do I get?

Your information sheet gives you all the details about parachuting, times, dates etc.

## What next?

Collect the sponsorship money, contact us again and we'll book you in for your jump.

## What's the tandem jump?

This is a 3000 metre jump with the thrill of free fall while being safely attached to your instructor.

## How much of what I raise goes to charity?

The expenses for training, organization and the jump are deducted from your sponsorship money and the remainder donated to the National Council for the Blind of Ireland.

## I'm not sure I want to jump, is there another way to help?
